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Comments: Personally i haven't seen a single set of anchors in my life before i started climbing, i didn't know what to look for, where to look for it, and it never once crossed my mind that climbing protection was ruining the environment and the land we care so much about. Another huge issue i see with this is the community, while you can try and ban acts like bolting or repair of bolts, people will do it anyway. These laws apply to the people who happily hike away from the rules of the world to get deep into the forest regularly, so what's stopping them doing it anyway. I think a better approach would be allow any set of bolts to be repaired because the damage to the rock is already done and for the safety of climbers these need to stay rust free and safe, i also think tracking the amount of new bolting in select areas and limiting to a certain amount per year could be a good way of making both parties happy.
