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Comments: You have allowed, managed, and authorized fixed anchors for decades in ways appropriate for the specific nature and wilderness areas without issue to the wildlife or land.

Restricting the establishment of new routes to "existing climbing opportunities" on non-Wilderness lands is unenforceable and will create confusion amongst land managers and climbers. Non-Wilderness climbing management policy should maintain opportunities for new anchors unless and until analyses determine climbing should be restricted to protect cultural and natural resources.
