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Comments: Climbing and climbing access into the wilderness via bolted routes seems to be no different from building hiking trails through protected alpine zones. I would love to see some actual research done about the impact climbing has on wilderness zones vs hikers and campers having on wilderness areas. Why would you want to take away our right to explore the wilderness and use safety tools such as fixed anchors to do so? All this bill would do is limit American's access to the lands we pay taxes to protect. If the parks were to hire climbing rangers to help educate the public on proper wilderness habits, just as they hire interpretive rangers to help educate the public on proper hiking habits, perhaps improper bolting wouldn't be as common. Please do more research about the impacts climbing might have on wilderness before trying to take away American's right to access the wilderness.
