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Comments: I am strongly against restricting fixed anchors in America's Wilderness areas. Fixed anchors are essential for climbing safety, and prohibiting them or obstructing their maintenance would endanger lives. The climbing community takes anchor and bolt maintenance very seriously, and several state and national organizations exist to monitor, maintain, and replace them as needed. Adding additional red tape would endanger climbers on historical routes that represent some of American climbing's greatest achievements, and remove exploration and recreational opportunities. If analyses determine that climbing in a certain area should be restricted, then by all means restrict it directly, not by making it more dangerous.
