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Comments: Prohibiting fixed anchors and bolts is the wrong choice for two reasons. One, climbers are an adventurous bunch and chances are high that the features will be climbed anyways. This will create unnecessary risk for climbers not experienced enough to understand their limits. It also will remove historical lines that have been inspiring climbers and non climbers alike for decades. Think about the fervor that Tommy Caldwell and Kevin Jorgeson created even outside the climbing community on their ascent of the Dawn Wall. The United States has a long history of climbing and to ban and remove bolts would be tearing down parts of that history.
