Comments: Stop the bolt prohibition! Why? Because *some* form of anchor is essential for safe ascent and descent. If bolts are to be disallowed, climbers will have to resort to creating temporary anchors using slings and other "tat" that invariably gets left behind, deteriorates with time, gets added to by other climbing parties and quickly collects into a large tangle of frayed and decaying spectra. Not only is this more dangerous and an eyesore, these temporary anchors are commonly placed around trees and other vegetation, causing erosion of the natural flora. Judicious and sparing placement (of hardly visible) bolts is the best solution, as has been sustainably practiced throughout the Alps among other long established climbing areas for generations
