Comments: Substantial land grabs by the Forest Service to privatize lands is not in the interest of the population of Valley and Adams County residents. Granite Mountain is an extremely popular recreational area and closing the area to snowmobiles, horseman, packers, and others by either outright banning of the groups or destruction of 60+ miles of roadway serves no interest to the general public, only to private entities.
