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Comments: Fixed anchors are a minimal and essential component for climbing safety and access. Restricting the establishment of new routes to "existing climbing opportunities" on non-Wilderness lands uses much too broad, vague, and over-arching language on a subject that should be specifically addressed to the nuances of particular areas. Climbing management policy should maintain opportunities for new anchors unless and until analyses determine climbing should be restricted to protect cultural and natural resources. Such a wide declaration is poor management.
