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Comments: I strongly oppose any limitation to access to climbing in wilderness. Fixed anchors should not be banned.. but rather maintained by climbing coalitions in conjunction with federal land management. In high use impact areas of wilderness I could see permits being issued for new route development, but any removal of anchors or bolts or limited access to climbing should be avoided. Climbing is a historical use of wilderness dating to the 1800s and even earlier with indigenous peoples.

It is my preferred method of experiencing wilderness and is consistent with the spirit of the wilderness act of 1974.
