I have comments and suggestions regarding the new bolting/fixing gear policy's. I would like to state that I don't agree and am very against over bolting however I do acknowledge that bolts are necessary and have to be maintained! I also agree that the amount of fixed gear used should be at a minimum and only when required. With this said I believe I have an idea that could benefit the land management team and the climbers using the land. Similar to a climbing ranger in Yosemite these areas could implement a "climbing sheriff" which could be an elected knowledgeable climber who could help regulate what is happening in the area and could be a mediator for climber to the management team and vice versa. I think this could really minimize the amount of bolts used and help with the overbolting and fixed gear problem. Thanks you for reading and considering my comments, I hope this can help!
