As a member of my local search and rescue team, I help out with rescues and recoveries in the Wind River Range. We don't have many fixed anchors in the Winds, but regularly have to fly into the wilderness for rescues and body recoveries due to anchor failures.

In my opinion we would all benefit from someone placing strong, durable anchors on some of our more popular climbs. The wilderness character would be better protected with responsible bolts placed to limit accidents, by reducing our need to fly helicopters. Any directive or new rule that prevents folks from placing responsible anchors should be weighed with the reality that rescues also disrupt wilderness character.
