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Comments: I'm very confused-- you want to make illegal the established, ethical, rock-respecting habit of climbing fixed anchors (by classifying this 50+ year old method as prohibited), thus endangering climbing safety and increasing ecological damage as risk alternatives are used? As well as dissuading climbers, one of the more eco-friendly visitors to national lands?

This is not well thought out. Unlike motorsports and other outdoor activities, climbing has a tradition of being light on the environment and respectful of the rock. Fixed anchors ('bolting') allows safe use without the stress of trees and dirt that alternative tie-downs would do. Please keep with the existing precedence that fixed anchors should be an allowable and maintained part of wilderness access.
