If I am lucky enough to be capable of visiting Wilderness, I DO NOT GO THERE TO SEE HUMAN STUFF, which includes glistening supposedly "better than more people putting in more anchors repeatedly placement of 'permanent anchors' " Rheinhold Messner spoke eloquently about NOT bringing the mts and cliffs down to us by artificial means. If you cannot climb something without drilling and bolting etc, do not degrade that rock. Perhaps in the future, someone more capable may be able to climb it without permanent scarring and defacing! LEAVE NO TRACE< especially in designated wilderness..
