The permanent closer of Granite Mountain does not make sense for many reasons and could be viewed as the privatization of public lands. This also can also set a precedence for others to follow.

The agreement that was reached years ago with the McCall Winter Recreation Collaborative should be upheld.

To close any area permanently to any group of users would be extremely hard to ever undo so Granite Mountain should remain a shared use area. Brundage Ski Resort has a master plan and the closer of Granite Mountain should be decided as part of that plan not in a separate deal.
