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Comments: I feel that a clause should be added to speed up, or negate, the process for needing to fill out a Minimum Requirements Analysis for an existing anchor, so long as it has the same impact on the environment that the previous anchor had. Ensuring anchors are in a healthy state - and replaced when becoming too worn - is an important part of ensuring climbing safety outdoors. By adding a massive requirement in the MRA - and likely a big time delay - I have concern that the routes with worn anchors will continue to be climbed and jeopardize the health of climbers.

With new anchors, I feel the Minimum Requirements Analysis makes sense to help ensure new routes are not negatively impacting our beautiful outdoor spaces.
