Comments: Mature forests are an essential part of the ecosystem. Besides their economic importance, forest provide crucial habitat, watersheds, climate benefits, and recreational opportunities. However, our past mismanagement of these vital resources have decimated the original forests which once covered vast swaths of the continent. Now, only a tiny fraction remain intact.
