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Comments: Fixed anchors used in climbing do not nearly affect the environment as much as other outdoor activities. They do not harm wildlife and routesetters even close routes when birds begin nesting along climbing routes in the wilderness as to allow them to peacefully nest without disturbance. The equipment provided in anchors and bolts provides safer easier learning opportunities for beginners so they do not have to start by learning on trad climbing which is much more dangerous. Overall the removal of anchors and bolts from wilderness areas will not make a significant impact on the surrounding area and will greatly impact the ability for climbing to propagate.
