Climbing anchors are NOT visible in Yosemite for example. This is a huge part of us as American outdoor athletes and you are going to take this away. Have you ever climbed? Ever been to the mountains on a 3000' wall? It will forever change you. One of the best companies, Patagonia in America was founded on climbing. It makes you a solid human being in this planet. You are wiping away a culture and community if this happens. Restricting the establishment of new routes to "existing climbing opportunities" on non-Wilderness lands is unenforceable and will create confusion amongst land managers and climbers. Non-Wilderness climbing management policy should maintain opportunities for new anchors unless and until analyses determine climbing should be restricted to protect cultural and natural resources.
