If you take away this long-standing practice, you will open the door for randomly placed bandit anchors in all kinds of random places. Also, this will also limit the climbing possibilities by removing safe decents from climbs. This is a limit on climbers' access to their public lands, something which has not been happening for 60+ years. This is a bad idea and one I wish you would reconsider. Thanks you.
