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Comments: Bolting in the wilderness is a required process for safety of travel. When traveling and exploring with my young children we rely on that safety to ensure we a pass through. If you climb with young kids, as they deserve the wild, they deserve seeing the land and understanding it, it's up to them to protect it in the future years. We use this safety gear with zero negative impact to the environment to pass through it.

a climber, I want to ensure the safe and responsible use of fixed anchors in forest such as CA Dinkey lakes or outside Yosemite and others remains available to the climbing community. I respect and advocate for the responsible use of Wilderness areas and believe that fixed anchors can be a component of a sustainable Wilderness experience. Please revise your climbing guidance to reflect the practice and precedent of the last 60+ years-that fixed anchors for climbing can be used, replaced, and maintained in designated Forest areas.
