Comments: Prohibiting fixed anchors in wilderness areas will drastically reduce the amount of climbing and canyoneering that can be done safely. The climbing community has had a long history of good trail maintenance, erosion control work, litter cleanup, fixed anchor maintenance, and raptor monitoring.
