One thing that probably hasn't been mentioned is that if you prohibit fixed anchors, then climbers will probably go back to hammering in pitons, and, since they're not allowed to leave them, they'll hammer them back out. This will destroy the rock. You can see the ramifications of this in Yosemite from back in the 70s when this was the norm. Lots of widening of cracks and general rock damage.

Also, this is just ridiculous. Y'all add so much infrastructure for other visitors to increase safety and a few tiny bolts here and there doesn't even compare. If you stop allowing bolting, especially replacement of old bolts, a lot of people will die because of it. Sure, you can tell them to stop climbing on the old bolts they find, but they're not going to listen. They'll get up there and be tired and clip into whatever they can find.
