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Comments: Fixed anchors are an essential piece of climbers' safety system; prohibiting at this points seems like a retrograde movement to a critical safety tool used commonly in climbing.

Prohibiting fixed anchors will create safety issues be inserting an unnecessary burden during a climb.

Prohibiting fixed anchors will threaten America's rich climbing legacy. If this prohibition means that existing fixed anchors will be removed, that means that some routes will cease to exist, thus erasing the history of climbing in the US.

Fixed anchors are maintained and replaced when necessary elsewhere in the US without controversy. That seems like a better approach than destroying existing safety tools and historical routes.
