As an avid climber and outdoor enthusiast, I am deeply committed to the conservation of Wilderness areas. and believe we need guidelines for managing fixed anchors in Wilderness. While I support the intent of the current guidelines for managing fixed anchors in Wilderness, I don't think that the Minimum Requirements Analysis, in its current form, adequately addresses the complexities of fixed anchor management. I propose adopting a more robust and clear framework that:

- (1) Explicitly defines fixed anchors, categorizing them based on their specific use cases within Wilderness areas.
- (2) Implements a more effective process for managing these anchors, one that goes beyond the current Minimum Requirements Analysis.
- (3) Grants individual Park and Forest Services greater autonomy in tailoring management strategies to the unique characteristics and needs of the lands they oversee.
