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Comments: This will essentially prevent guides and recreationalists from making reasonable risk management decisions. As professionals and recreationalists we strive to limit our impacts while educating our friends and clients on responsible recreation. Planning almost any climb without the possibility of improvising fixed anchors(on a limited essential basis, as we do) would be a reckless decision. People will always access climbs on public land. When more rescues have to happen because of this, the impact, including the necessity of fixed anchors by rescue personal will result in a much higher and more destructive impact to public lands!
