During my 50 years of active outdoor recreation I have found climbers to be respectful, concerned for the environment and incredibly safety conscious. Unlike many other wilderness users such as mountain bikers, casual amateur hikers and hunters, the impact of climbing on fixed routes appears to me to be of limited impact. I have witnessed local climber volunteers out doing trail repair and participatingating in trail upkeep.
