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Comments: With a trained eye and a guidebook it is still hard to see anchors from the ground, often never seeing them at all unless climbing. Furthermore this makes it much less safe.

Restricting the establishment of new routes to "existing climbing opportunities" on non-Wilderness lands is unenforceable and will create confusion amongst land managers and climbers. Non-Wilderness climbing management policy should maintain opportunities for new anchors unless and until analyses determine climbing should be restricted to protect cultural and natural resources.
