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Comments: I believe that the resolution is too broad and will lead to avoidable conflict between climbers and park services.

Minimally invasive is a pretty broad term. Does this mean rangers will be in charge of cutting bolts that are deemed not needed? What happens when a climber is injured due to a fall that was bigger or more dangerous due to removal of protection by park or forest services.

Instead we should focus on teaching climbing ethics and morals to new and existing climbers with a think before you bolt practice and follow already existing permitting/process in place for new route establishment.
