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Comments: Fixed anchors are essential to climbing. They have been in use for many decades. Fixed anchors have made possible some of the greatest human powered achievements of each decade. Not being able to install them when essential to safety, nor replace them when judged to be faulty will lead to significant issues and even make it impossible to enjoy climbing resources that have were established long ago. It is not feasible to expect the government to police or monitor or oversee installations, whether existing or new. It is not reasonable to remove existing anchors that would become illegal under this legislation. Banning the hardware would likely instigate secretive anchor installation and destroy any positive relationships built between the government services and the climbing community.
