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Comments: I strongly disagree with the prohibition of climbing safety bolts in the wilderness. As a climber who goes out into these wilderness areas, Joshua tree, the sierras, Yosemite, I have used existing bolts and climbing anchors. These are not an eyesore and are for the most part not noticeable. They are hundreds of feet in the air on large walls. Without these many not only climbs, but peaks and walls would be inaccessible to recreation. These are only used when necessary when no other removable safety gear can be used. Prohibition of safety bolts would also prevent any new routes, in new areas to be accessed. Many of these areas are rarely used by visitors who are not climbers, as they are usually out of the way and difficult to extremely difficult and inconvenient to access.

Please do not limit the use of safety for the recreating climbing public.
