Comments: It is important that the Forest Service keep to its trustworthiness which is to preserve the wilderness reputation which is to preserve the wilderness character of the "Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex." It should also not promote any actual use, such as outfitting or guiding.

With this reauthorization of the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex Outfitter and Guide Permit it lacks any site-specific important information, and this is despite requesting site-specific statements. For that reason, the Forest Service must make the following information accessible for us the public to review on its website and must also extend the public comment time for an additional 45 days after the information is published on the website:

- 1) show permitted service days vs. actual use for each permit
- 2) annual inspections, performance evaluations, or public complaints correlated to each campsite or operator
- 3) any NEPA documents and related decisions dealing with outfitting service levels or allocation in the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex
- 4) the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex Character Narrative
- 5) 2017 needs assessment and extent necessary documentation
- 6) Campsite Management Plans for each outfitter camp

The Forest Service, because of the many impacts outfitting has on the Wilderness, must not use a Categorical Exclusion (CE) to renew any outfitter permits. To properly protect this legendary Wilderness Complex; it is important that an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement with additional public input is part of the review.
