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Comments: I strongly believe that it is important that fixed anchors are allowed in the national parks. Fixed anchors provide important safety to climbers in the NPS, preventing needless accidents, injuries, and deaths. Existing policies, which have allowed fixed anchors for over 50 years, work to protect the national parks experience already. This rule would also have a negative impact on land manager/climber relationships, making land managers function as police when many overlap with the climbing community and the two groups share manage goals. Drill-free bolting should be allowed to continue in national parks to protect climbers safety and prevent land manager/recreation conflict.
