Comments: We should not be selling old-growth trees on public lands. You can manage these forests effectively without selling those trees. End of story.

? We need solutions that match the magnitude of the threats we face. Conserving mature and old-growth forests on federal lands is a critical natural climate solution that will have a meaningful impact on the climate crisis and biodiversity crisis. We have a moral imperative to act boldly.

? An amendment curbing old-growth logging is an important first step. Now, the Administration needs to finish the job by developing a rule to robustly protect mature forests and trees. Mature trees - or 'future old-growth' - hold the vast majority of the carbon stored on the national forest system, and they must be conserved as part of a climate solution.

? There are projects in the pipeline that threaten mature and old-growth trees. Thank you for including an elevated review process, but please make sure these current projects are re-evaluated in light of the pressing need to reverse the loss of old-growth. Please also consider a moratorium on all mature and old-growth logging projects until this plan amendment can be implemented.
