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Comments: I'm apposed to alternative 2 and 3 because of a loss of AUMS. The NEPAs show there's more suitable acreage for domestic sheep than cows. It's been said that it's too dry for sheep but cows require more water than sheep do.

I don't understand why this was not reissued through the grant process as a sheep allotment. The forest service has said that the best use of the land is grazing.

Surely considering the economic impact grazing has on rural communities, and the fact it was turned in without preference, the rules should have been followed of how this allotment was transferred.
