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Comments: The proposal to log Dixie-Comstock is ungrounded in science or truth. There is no grand emergency, this area has burned in patches already, naturally. Science shows that protecting structures is best done on the immediate structural-level, 40 feet around buildings. Removing trees further than that is not protective for fire. Thus, this proposal appears misleading and an excuse to log. It is also a roadless area and a zone for wildlife connectivity- between the Frank Church River of No Return and the Gospel Hump wilderness areas. It is an especially bad idea for species diversity and survival to create "islands" of habitat. I do not believe this proposal is necessary or grounded in the best environmental or fire science. I am opposed.
