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Comments: I am against the proposed Dixie-Comstock, the logging and burning of the Cove-Mallard Roadless Area. This is a healthy area that has recently burned and therefore presents little if any fire danger. This means there is no emergency need to log. In fact, because of the recent fires, logging would damage the soils and watersheds, which the USFS is supposed to protect.

Roadless areas are meant to stay roadless. They provide essential wildlife habitats and throughways as well as spaces for people to experience the wonders of nature without the sounds of civilization breaking in. Please work to create forest plans that protect our dwindling roadless and wilderness areas.
