This revision would allow the reissuance of the ANILCA special use permit for the continuation of the traditional and customary purposes for which the cabin was built, and to ensure stewardship of National Forest service lands is reasonably maintained.

Our cabin type is: Isolated Cabin, Permit Use Code: 121 Tongass National Forest Admiratly Island National Monument Ranger District.

Historical Context: This cabin was built in the 1950s by a trapper named Eli Post. This was his main cabin used to maintain a livelihood of trapping, hunting, and fishing. My grandfather purchased the cabin from Virgina Post, Eli's wife after he passed on. My entire family, from grandfather, as well as my father, uncles, brothers and sisters and I have all continued to use the cabin for the very same purposes in which it was originally built, for "traditional and customary uses" of hunting, trapping and fishing.
