Comments: Congress passed the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) to protect nationally significant public land in Alaska for all of us. Unauthorized cabins had already been constructed on federal lands, inside and outside areas ANILCA subsequently designated as Wilderness.
