Comments: The US Forest Service acted wisely when it adopted rules for the continued existence of pre-1980 cabins in wilderness areas, subject to long-term phasing out. Closing these cabins over time is the right way to preserve Alaska's precious wilderness areas, and I'm writing to oppose amending the original plan under ANILCA.
