Comments: I am writing to ask you to leave the restrictions in place regarding ANILCA cabins. These cabins should be phased out and allowed to terminate when existing immediate family members die. This would restore the normal rules for Wilderness lands in Alaska, with the end of the use of permanent structures.

Cabins don't belong in designated Wilderness. The U.S. Forest Service must leave its policy unchanged and phase out ANILCA cabins, as was the original intent. These cabins were never meant to persist in Wilderness, and to change this policy would undermine ANILCA and the Wilderness Act.
