Under the provisions of ANILCA, your agency put into a place a phase out of the ownership and occupancy of these structures. The permits were supposed to expire upon the death of the last immediate family member of the original claimant. This policy was enacted by the US Forest Service in 1987 to keep Alaskan wilderness wild, which is the intent of ANILCA.
