Comments: The USFS created a specific policy dealing with the planned phasing out of the ANILCA cabins from the national forest. The USFS needs to follow through on that policy and remove the cabins as explicitly proposed. I oppose any remodeling of a rule that continues the use off the ANILCA cabins. This is of the utmost importance to cabins located among designated wilderness.

In summary I oppose the proposed revision to Alaska Region Supplement Forest Service Handbook 2709.11, Chapters 40 and 50: Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act Cabin Policy, and Associated Permit Terms and Conditions. Maintain special use authorizations for the ANILCA cabins and phase them out as originally intended.
