Comments: When the U.S Forest Service created the program issuing special-use permits for unauthorized cabins, the permits were renewable every five years and nontransferable, terminating upon the death of the last immediate family member of the original claimant. The intent was to phase out these cabins, as this is wilderness, which is managed for its wildness.

Please refrain from removing restrictions on these permits. Cabins don't belong in designated wilderness, and it's important that the U.S. Forest Service leave its policy unchanged and phase out ANILCA cabins, as was the original intent. These cabins were never meant to persist in wilderness, and to change this policy would undermine ANILCA and the Wilderness Act.
