Comments: Dear USFS, Please withhold my personal information from public view. I am writing in response to your ANILCA cabin policy. Cabins are structures that do not conform with the Wilderness Act, and therefore should not be allowed in designated wilderness areas. The USFS should NOT -- i repeat NOT -- change its policy that has long called for the phase out of cabins analyzed during the extensive ANILCA process. The clear intent of the public and decision-makers was to phase out cabins in Alaskan wilderness, and that should NOT be changed or weakened. It was never intended during the ANILCA process that these cabins would be allowed to persist in designated wilderness areas. To change this policy now would be an arbitrary, capricious and indefensible reversal, and an affront to ANILCA and the Wilderness Act.
