Comments: I'm a 75yo who is extremely concerned about the environment and wildlife. When originally established, the exemption provision regarding ANILCA cabins was to terminate special-use permits for these unauthorized cabins once the last immediate family member of the original claimant died. That recognized that these cabins don't belong in designated Wilderness. The U.S. Forest Service must leave its policy unchanged and phase out ANILCA cabins, as originally intended. These cabins were never meant to persist in Wilderness, and to change this policy would undermine ANILCA and the Wilderness Act.
