Comments: It has just come to my attention that the Forest Service is (once again) expressing its disregard for land designated as Wilderness and the provisions of the Wilderness Act, this time in Alaska. So I write to state my opposition to any proposal to allow any cabins on ANILCA lands designated as Wilderness to remain in place or to relax and other aspects to the original plan, which was to remove such cabins soon.
