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Comments: After At-Risk-Species suitable habitat is evaluated/documentated in the Draft EIS; individual maps showing population density are needed for each species map, for clarity so one has a better idea where they/their suitable habitats are located in the LNF.

For example, use a similar map for the Monarch Butterfly in the EIS as in the LNF Land Management Plan Revised Assessment- Monarch Categorical Model (Appendix I, Fig. 1-31) showing suitability with overlay of population density. With more specific locations on the map(s), this will make At-Risk-Species Maps more informative and reader-friendly.
