Comments: I object to your finding that the Sandwich Vegetation Management Project provides no major threat to our forest. I have commented several times on this project and do not see any significant response to either my or others objections.

- 1). The project poses a major threat to our forest evolving into an old growth forest capable of sequestering carbon and contributing positively to the climate crisis the earth now faces. At the least you should address Executive Order 14072 explicitly.
- 2). The use of parking lots that are now full and overflowing during the hiking season is a major threat to the recreational use of the forest. It is one of only two major national forests within driving distance of major east coast population centers; its recreational use is of far more importance to the nation than its use as a source of board feet to lumber.
- 3). The project is an aesthetic threat to one of the loveliest parts of the WMNF.
