Please continue Wilderness designation:

1) the Hoodoo with current boundaries, including the Great Burn (one of the wildest areas in the Lower 48 providing vital habitat for wolverines, mountain goats, grizzly bears, and other sensitive species), 2) 1986 recommended Wilderness for the Lolo Creek and Quigg/Slide Rock Areas.

Hoped for recommended Wilderness designation in proposed Plan:

- 1) the Ward Eagle and Meadow Creek-Upper North Fork roadless areas to protect the areas incredible wild character,
- 2) the Stony Mountain roadless area, which is also important for the Rock Creek watershed,
