As a resident of Crook county for several decades and having ridden in the forest, and the Corral Flats area extensively, for many of those years, the area is in need of repair caused by illegal OHV use. I like the proposal to create barriers that will prevent future damage by OHV's, restore the habitat and decrease user conflict.

I would also like to mention the problem of feral horses and trail rider conflict. Riding a mare around the feral horses can be dangerous not only for the domesticated horse but their rider too. Having personally had a young feral stallion aggressively attack my horse. The Corral Flats area is out of the WHMA and the feral horses need to be returned to their area. This has only become an issue in recent years as the feral horse population has grown to the current high numbers.
